

INDICATORS FOR POTENTIAL VISION PROBLEMS

APPEARANCE

- ___ One eye turns in or out
- ___ Closes an eye or tilts head for near tasks
- ___ Red eyes or lids or crust on eyelids
- ___ Excessive blinking or tearing of eyes

NEAR & DISTANCE VISUAL ACUITY

- ___ Holds things close to eyes
- ___ Needs to sit close to board to read it
- ___ Thrusts head forward when looking at distance

Comments:

VISUAL FIELDS

- ___ Difficulty with changes in elevation
- ___ Bumps into things
- ___ Doesn't read to the end of a sentence before going to the next

Comments:

EYE TRACKING

- ___ Head moves instead of eyes when reading or looking at pictures
- ___ Loses place when reading and skips lines
- ___ Difficulty solving maze puzzles, i.e., word searches

EYE-TEAMING

- ___ Fatigues during near visual tasks, short interest span
- ___ Difficulty judging where things are in space
- ___ Difficulty following flight of a ball
- ___ Math errors due to misalignment of numbers
- ___ Tires easily, inattentive, poor concentration

Comments:

VISUAL MOTOR

- ___ Difficulty writing on lined paper
- ___ Difficulty with spacing between words
- ___ Difficulty copying from the board
- ___ Difficulty with tracing or cutting on lines

ADAPTATION TO LIGHTING CHANGES

- ___ Pauses when coming indoors on sunny days
- ___ Slow adjustment to lighting changes
